What you'll do

We need someone who will oversee our warehouse and volunteer activities at our Rock Branch facility in Poca. If you enjoy hands-on physical work, are highly motivated, can initiate action and motivate others, then the Branch Coordinator position is for you. This position works to provide our volunteers guidance and ensures that our product is built and delivered in a safe and timely manner. You will be working as a liaison between other departments and the Director of Rock Branch to accommodate for any CSFP or volunteer activities. Your hands will move the food that feeds our neighbors in West Virginia.

Here are examples of what you'll be doing everyday:

- Provide leadership and training to ensure that all work is completed in a correct, safe, and timely manner.
- Doing inventory (we count everyday) it's critical to our success.
- Stage product for efficient pickups.
- Using cool equipment such as pallet jacks, forklifts and reach trucks (we do on-site safety training).
- Keep our warehouse spiffy clean-food safety is #1.
- Do your part to help us run smoothly and pitch in wherever you can to advance our mission

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And then there's you....

- Want to be the best. You thrive in a fast-paced environment with tight deadlines, and are always thinking two steps ahead of everyone else.
- Not afraid to work hard. Working at a food bank is tough work, but every day you are feeding a struggling family in West Virginia.
- Willing to roll with the punches. We schedule as much as we can, but every day brings new challenges.
- Team orientated. The person in this role must be willing to help out their team to get the job finished right, but also be able to delegate tasks to reach optimal efficiency.

This position is described as **Moderate/Heavy** performing strenuous daily warehouse activities. This position requires lifting or carrying items more than 75% of the time. Frequency of weight lifted is as follows: up to 50 lbs. over 2/3 of the time. This position requires safe and efficient operation of heavy machinery (i.e. forklift and electric pallet jack). This position requires the individual to provide volunteers guidance and ensures that MFB's product is built and delivered in a safe and timely manner. This position works as a liaison between other departments and the Director of Rock Branch to accommodate for any CSFP or volunteer activities. The work environment varies between a well-lighted walk in cooler and a well-lighted warehouse. The noise level varies, but it is usually moderate.

Equipment Used: Computer/laptop, telephone, copier, printer, forklift, electric pallet jack, manual pallet jack, box cutter, tape gun, stretch wrap, and other packing material

Position Summary

MFB partners with agencies to serve senior citizens through our CSFP program. With that being said, the Branch Coordinator will ensure that the CSFP boxes are built for these programs in a safe and timely manner. This position will receive various shipments of product on a monthly basis and be required to keep an accurate daily inventory of this product. In addition, the Branch Coordinator works alongside volunteers and staff on a daily basis to make sure that boxes are built and various other activities are completed. The Branch Coordinator aims to keep food safe, work efficient, and a fun atmosphere amongst workers/volunteers.

Attributes & Values:

This position requires an individual that is passionate, focused and shows creativity around the Food Bank vision, mission, and values.

- **Motivated** intrinsically motivated, diligent and push yourself to do your best work. Always looking for new ways to grow and improve.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Volunteer Engagement

- Assist in organizing volunteer activities
- Engage volunteers in a positive environment
- Create goals for volunteers to achieve
- Work efficiently with volunteers to complete the intended outcome

Operations Management

- Maintain a daily inventory with less than 2% variance
- Maintain sanitary, safe food handling practices in the warehouse
- Ensure that all food safety standards are met to keep the highest level of integrity for all products

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- Maintain physical layout of warehouse that allows an organized and efficient flow of food, while maximizing space
- Unload deliveries and provide an accurate account of all incoming products to the inventory clerk
- Rotate food on a "first in-first out" basis
- Ensure that short shelf life food is distributed to agencies in a timely manner
- Stage agency orders according to MFB
- Load delivery/transfer trucks according to MFB
- Communicate with staff who contribute to the overall success of the program/activity

Operations Maintenance

- Maintain cleanliness of the food bank warehouse
- Maintain cleanliness of the food bank equipment
- Report all maintenance need or problems to the Director of Rock Branch

- Occasionally required to operate warehouse equipment and machines and recognize safety hazards in the workplace.
- Must be able to lift, carry, and balance objects weighing up to fifty pounds.
- Must be able to hear, see, read, and communicate verbally and in writing frequently with a wide range of people from divergent socio-economic and cultural backgrounds and origins.

- Demonstrate a professional demeanor in interactions with all MFB staff, volunteers, agencies, donors, government officials and the public.
